With that, four women, encouraged by Charlotte Purcell and led by Catherine Donahue, decided that their lives were worth more than the value Radium Dial Company had placed on them in the 1920s. Their decision to be heard helped shape the U.S. labor laws, workers compensation and radiation safety standards we rely on todav.
