

Degrees offered

Students can earn associate of arts (AA), associate of science (AS) or associate of general studies (AGS) degrees for transfer for a four-year degree. The associate of applied arts and sciences (AAAS) degree is granted to students who complete a two-year degree program and can also be used for transfer. The bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) degree is a four-year degree program for students studying the nursing profession.
